3. Pre-Qualification Criteria:

Clause 2.2 (i), regarding ISO 9000 certification, is hereby waived. It is not required to submit a copy of the ISO 9000 certificate.

4. Bid Validity:

Clause 2.14 (a) stands modified as:

Bids shall be valid for a period 120 days from the last date of submission of Bids or the extended date thereof. NGS reserves the right to reject any Bid, which does not meet this requirement. On completion of the validity period, unless the bidder withdraws his proposal in writing, it will be deemed to be valid until such time that the Bidder formally (in writing) withdraws his proposal. Prior to the expiry of the original Bid Validity Period, NGS may, at its discretion, request Bidders to extend the Bid Validity Period for a specified additional period. In such cases, the validity of EMD shall also be suitably extended.

5. Specification of Equipment

The following text is incorporated in Annexure 6 of the RFP:

“Specifications are indicative. Any specification equivalent to this, and accepted by the ICF (International Canoeing Federation), is accepted. Copy of the Certificate from ICF (International Canoeing Federation), approving the specification, should be attached.”
