1	Some of our suppliers are not ready to accept the NGS payment terms. If the Indian authorized agent makes an advance payment to the supplier, would it be possible for the purchaser to open an L/C in the name the Indian agent. Alternatively, without an L/c being opened, would it be possible for the purchaser to make a payment as per the payment conditions to the Indian agent on shipment, on production of the stipulated documents. Kindly advise. The material will be invoiced to the Purchaser.	<p>The Letter of Acceptance will be issued to the Foreign Supplier. The materials have to be invoiced to the Purchaser.</p> <p>NGS can make payment to the Indian Agent against confirmation from the foreign supplier that payment has been received from the Indian Agent.</p> <p>Payment can be made as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>A. On Shipment 80% of the CIF value can be paid to the Indian Agent upon submission of documents specified in clause 2.29 a (ii) (a).</li> <li>B. On Acceptance 20% of the CIF can be paid to the Indian Agent against Final Inspection and Acceptance Certificate of goods issued by the consignees, subject to recoveries, if any.</li> <li>C. Payment of Customs Clearance and handling charges, Loading/Unloading, Inland Transportation,</li> </ul>

2	Whether only fulcrum is required	<b>Fulcrum is NOT required. Only Springboards are required.</b> The Selected Bidder should install the equipment. Bidders should quote accordingly.
3	Whether stands are required. If yes, what type, size and whether hand rails are required.	Stands are not required
4	Installation location and details like drawing, fixture availability and other relevant information	The springboards are to be installed in the Aquatics Complex, Pirappancode, Thiruvananthapuram District, Kerala.  Please note that this is an operational diving well. The existing springboards have to be replaced with new spring boards in the fulcrums fitted in the diving platform. 5	Details of the pool where the diving boards has to fixed like FINA approval, specifications, etc.	The pool is of international standards and conforms to FINA specifications. 1 mt platform – 2 boards and 3mt platform – 2

		boards. <b>Total 4 springboards required. (Please note the change in quantities)</b>

As we are close to the major holidays in Europe, we need to have more clarity on the date of opening of financial bid and date of award of the tender, without which it becomes difficult to make delivery commitments.
